

# REPRESENTATIVE OF AN OVERSEAS BUSINESS VISA (ROB)



## Do you part-own or work for an overseas company:

- Is it an active and trading overseas business?
- Does it have its HQ and principal place of business outside the UK?
- Will its HQ remain outside of the UK?
- Does it want to set up a business presence in the UK?
- Will it actively trade in the same type of business as the overseas business?

## If the answer is YES, can you demonstrate that you:

- Are an existing senior employee of the overseas business.
- Have the skills, experience and knowledge necessary to undertake the role.
- Have full authority to negotiate and take operational decisions.
- Intend to work full-time as a representative of the business in the UK.
- Will not engage in business on your own or represent other business interests in the UK.
- Do not have a majority stake in the overseas business.
- Are competent in the English language.
- Can maintain and accommodate yourself and your dependants.



You could be eligible for this 3-year visa. The visa can be extended for a further 2 years.

After 5 years, you can apply for permanent residence.

## Advantages:

- ✓ Allows you to access the UK market and do international business from the UK.
- ✓ Allows you to bring your dependants to the UK (partners and children under 18).
- ✓ Your dependants can study, work or engage in business activity.
- ✓ You can apply for Indefinite Leave to Remain (ILR) after 5 years.
